Renew Burnie is an initiative from Business Northwest (*Burnie Chambers of Commerce*), supported by the Burnie City Council, that is squarely focussed on revitalising the Burnie CBD by encouraging emerging, creative, and innovative business enterprises to establish themselves in highly visible retail spaces. Through our partnership with Renew Australia we draw from their success and learnings to our Renew Burnie project.

Where abouts are the shops located?

At this stage we have shops available in the Burnie Plaza Arcade and the City Arcade. We can show you through ones that are available to see if they work for you.

Can I share a shop, or do I have to licence the whole space by myself?

No- You can share a space whether as a collective, or as separate artisans working together in a space.

How often do I need to be open?

Ideally, we would love you to be open as often as you can or arrange for someone to look after the shop if you can't make it. There may be times in the future where we have events where we will require you to be open, but we will let you know with plenty of notice.

How long do I have to stay in the space for?

It's a 30-day rolling licence to occupy the space. Either party can give notice to vacate.

Can I lease the shop myself?

Absolutely! If your business is doing well, and you want to stay put, then we can transfer you on to a lease agreement with the usual lease arrangements.
